Ethnic-Minority Scholarship Competition Criteria**

Applicants can be male or female who plan to attend a 4-year college or university, or a community/technical school. At least one scholarship will be awarded to a legacy student (son or daughter of an Active Alpha Lambda Omega Soror), based on highest rating. **NOTE: The Soror is responsible for notifying the Scholarship Committee of legacy application(s).**

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

1. GPA of 2.5 or higher
2. SAT score of 750 or higher (combined Math and Critical Reading)
3. Demonstrated leadership capabilities (church, school, community service)
4. Evidence of financial need
5. Member of an ethnic-minority group
6. Applicant must be entering college as a freshman for the fall of 2010

APPLICATION MATERIALS SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. Scholarship application form
2. One page typed essay demonstrating financial need and why applicant desires the scholarship
3. Two letters of support from school, community, church, or employers
4. An official transcript, listing class rank and GPA
5. Copy of acceptance letter from the institution the student plans to attend
6. Photograph of applicant (headshot, passport, or school photo)
7. SAT scores (sealed copy)
8. Self-addressed stamped envelope

Items 1 – 8 must be submitted as a complete package. (Note: Incomplete packages will not be considered) All materials submitted with the application, including photographs, become the property of Alpha Lambda Omega Chapter, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., and may be used for promotional purposes. Submission of an application constitutes your authorization and release.
